A TEACH & PLAY LESSON · MEMBER NOT VISITOR · 1 CORINTHIANS 12:27

"Now you are the **body of Christ** and individually members of it." — 1 Corinthians 12:27

The game was loud. This part is just for you. Be honest — no one else reads this.

1. Right now, I treat church more like... *(circle one)*
