"This is the will of God, your sanctification: that you **abstain from sexual immorality.**" — 1 Thessalonians 4:3

1. Dating in my life right now is... *(circle one)*

- Only seriously date a believer who honors God
- Decide boundaries ahead of time — and flee lust (2 Tim. 2:22)

4. Tonight I'm choosing... *(circle)*

- ▶ To honor God on every date — even when it's unpopular
- ▶ To ask God for wisdom before the next invitation
- ▶ To talk to a leader if I've already crossed a line

5. My prayer, in my own words:

"Lord — I date who I might marry, so help me honor You on every date. When culture says fool around, help me flee what You told me to run from. Guard my heart, my body, and my witness. Teach me patient, sacrificial love — not lust dressed up as romance. If I've already failed, lead me to repentance and a fresh start. Amen."
