A TEACH & PLAY LESSON · HEAR THE GOOD NEWS · ROMANS 10:9

*“If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and **believe in your heart** that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.” — Romans 10:9*

The game was loud. This part is just for you. Be honest — no one else reads this.

1. When I hear “the gospel,” I honestly think it means... *(circle one)*

- ▶ Good news about what Jesus did — died, buried, rose, reigns

2. Right now, my relationship with Jesus is mostly...

3. One sin or habit I know I need to turn from is... *(repentance starts with honesty)*

4. Tonight, what I want to say yes to is... *(circle any)*

- Turn to God and trust Jesus as Lord for the first time
- Re-turn — I believed before but I've been drifting
- Ask God to make the gospel clear in my heart, not just my head

5. My prayer, in my own words:

“Jesus — I hear the news. You died for my sin, were buried, and rose again. I turn from my way. I trust You alone. You are my Lord. Amen.”

Turn toward God. Trust Christ alone.
